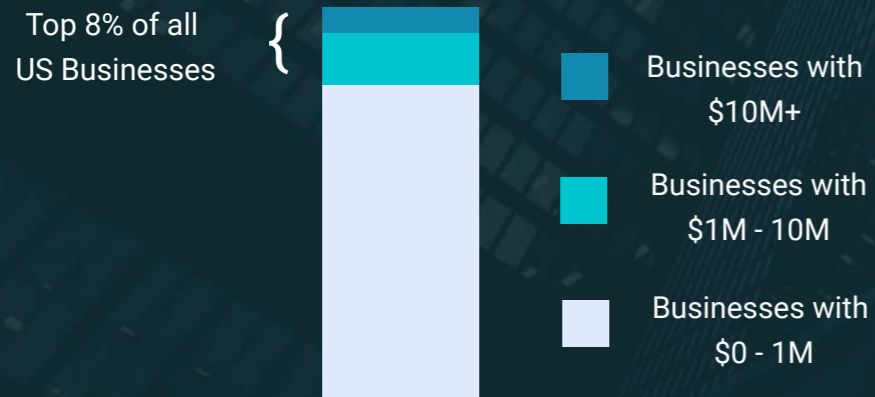

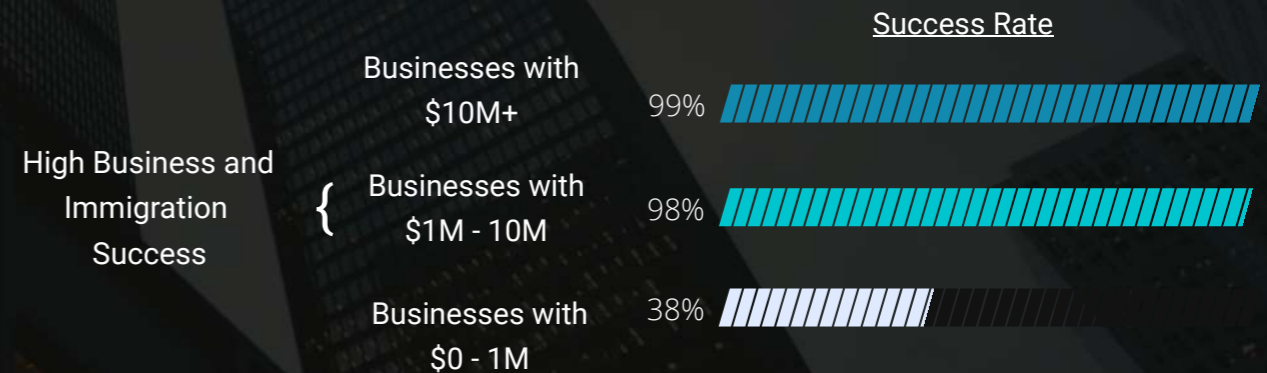
Businesses recommended by EIC are in the top 8% in terms of gross sales of all American businesses, according to recent data from SBA and NAICS.

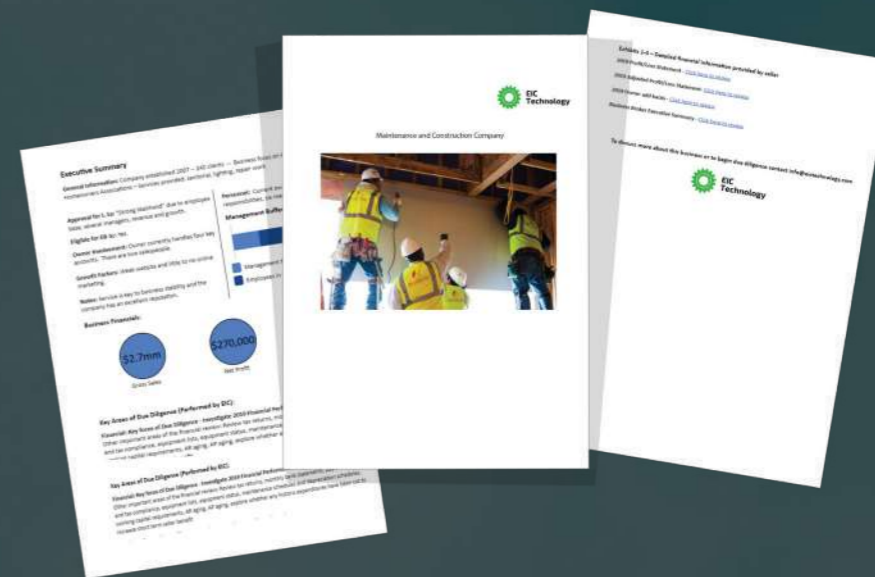
